


Dropping Linked Courses

There is a fundamental difference between linked components that have only one section, and those with multiple sections:

1. If the course has only one section (ANTH 0300 for example) then you can drop all components by dropping the S section. ***NOTE: This does not apply to a course that has more than one component required (MCM 0240 has a section, a conference and filming) for such courses please refer to #2**







3. Dropping non-linked courses still works as expected.

Swapping

1. You can still swap components within the same course - C01 for C02 for example
2. You can still swap in non-component courses as usual
3. You can still swap *in* courses with components
4. You cannot swap out courses with components, you have to drop the course with components first, and then add the new course separately. This is true for both courses with one section and multiple sections. For example, I tried to swap AFRI 0370 in for ANTH 0300 by following these steps.

Course Description

Literary historians generally agree that in the 1970s, in the U.S., there was a significant increase in the publication of diverse forms of African American literature. The 1970s is also often described by scholars as a decade in which there was a renaissance of African American women's writing as well as the publication of several experimental African American literary works. In this seminar, we will study this lively period in African American literary history primarily through novels, some of them recently republished or adapted into other forms. What idea of African American literature do we get when we read novels from this era? What questions were asked in 1970s African American novels that we continue to ask now? Novels we will likely read include detective fiction, diaristic fiction, satirical fiction, a love story, and historical fiction.




